For **Book** references, there is no dedicated field for **Edition**. With this change, a new **Edition** field will be added for book references. This field will be configurable in **Project settings** like other reference fields.

The initial roll out will allow **Adding**, **Batch Editing**, and **Configuring** the Edition field.

Subsequent roll outs will:

- Display additional data for reference searches
- Include the **Edition** field in **reports**,
- Improve the user interface to promote **Searching** before **Adding**
- **Merge Duplicates**

Changes to error notifications for Validators

When Validators validate an item, they do not receive any errors if the item is missing **required Metadata** or if the **Asset** attached to the item is in an **incomplete state**. Moving forward, users will start getting error messages when the item advances to the Validate state if the item is missing required Metadata and/or if the item includes incomplete Assets.
