

7.2 Committees


The **Observer Dashboard for Committees** displays the progress of various tasks of the group of users who form a committee.

As an Observer in ExamDeveloper, you can observe the progress in the project that users are working on, from the **Observer Dashboard** page:

1. Blueprint level for the project currently selected.
2. The duration of the project and the number of days assigned to complete the project.
3. Status of items by blueprint.
4. Status of items by metadata.
5. Progress of activity by user assignments (writers, reviewers, and validators).

Access the Observer Dashboard page for committees

Select the **Observe Committees** menu.
